**Current Projects**

Discussion was held on the obligation of the Washington State Department of Transportation maintaining the waterway through the Town of Wilbur known as Goose Creek.

Expectations – flow size, not based on the 100 year flood. 1931 design was 12ft deep and 20ft wide. Most likely work the creek in 2010.

DOT must make formal design that can be let for contract. Cost is greater than normal Stat DOT maintenance, budget. The DOT must get assignment of funds for project. Go to the Legislators with plan.

Yearly maintenance plan to reduce future cost. Access to creek at East end and West of Division.

Equipment use will be driven by type of permits obtained.

Step 1 Extend of work to accomplish.

Step 2 Survey the creek for design

Step 3 Set profile & design

Step 4 Write scope for bid

Step 5 Supply notes & data from Army Corp. and TD&H. Combine the information for the best study.

Step 6 Money for project from Legislators.

Find close area to place spoils.

Explore matching money for future large grants, by using the State DOT yearly maintenance funds to do bigger creek projects.
