



DOG LICENSING INFORMATION:

- All dogs living within the Wilbur town limits must be licensed.
- All licenses are good for one calendar year, January – December.
- Licenses must be renewed every year after January 1st.
Fees are:
 - \$10.00 for spayed/neutered
 - \$15.00 for non-spayed/neutered

LICENSE FEES DOUBLE IF NOT PURCHASED
PRIOR TO **MARCH 1st** OF EACH YEAR
- There is a limit of 3 dogs per household.

CAT LICENSING INFORMATION:

- The Town of Wilbur does not require you to obtain a cat license. However, cat licenses are available to those who wish for a fee of \$5.00.
