

RESOLUTION #293
TDD/TTY POLICY
for
THE TOWN OF WILBUR

WHEREAS, the Town of Wilbur deems it necessary to adopt a procedure for communication with the hearing impaired to comply with the requirements of the Community Development Block Grant(CDBG) program and help make the Town of Wilbur activities more accessible to the hearing impaired; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following is adopted as a plan of action and procedure instituted to assure access by the hearing impaired in lieu of the purchase of a TDD/TTY (Telephonic Device for the Deaf)/Teletypewriter).

1. The Town of Wilbur will publicize the availability of TDD/TTY service through the use of the state-wide 1-800 phone numbers of the Relay Service for both Voice and TDD/TTY. These numbers will be included in the Town's web site and added to the Town of Wilbur's letterhead when it is reprinted commercially.
2. The Town of Wilbur will post the TDD/TTY Relay Service phone numbers on the Council agenda and in Town Hall.
3. The Town of Wilbur has contacted the Washington Relay Service (TDD) and will be provided with brochures and training regarding issues of communication with the hearing impaired.
